## **7. INSURANCE**

The inscription includes the insurance fee, which guaranties the civil responsibility of the competitor toward third parties. The maximum indemnity per accident is limited to € 20.000.000 or € 6.000.000 in corporal or material damages, respectively.

## **IV.CHECKING**

### **9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKING**

9.1 Only drivers must report to administrative checking which will be held at the circuit RCT.

### **10. SCRUTINEERING**

10.1 No car will be allowed to start unless it complies with the current FIA safety regulations (Appendix J and M).

The Technical Delegate appointed by the FIA will be responsible for scrutineering and will have full authority over the national Scrutineers.

#### **10.2. Noise**

For all cars, a limit of 100 dB is imposed, measured with a noise pressure meter regulated at "A" and "SLOW", placed at an angle of 45° to and a distance of 50 cm from the exhaust outlet, whit the cars engine turning at 4500 revolutions per minute.

#### **10.7. TYRES**

The fitting of heat retaining devices or pre-heating is prohibited. This applies both wet-weather and dry-weather tyres.

## **V. RUNNING OF THE EVENT**

### **12. PRACTICE AND DRIVERS INFORMATION**

12.1. Free practice and two official timed practice sessions, one organised in order and the second in reversed order are obligatory in each division.

There will be not more than 6 cars in each timed practice session, which will last for 5 laps from the entry of the first car onto the track, but only the times starting from the 2<sup>nd</sup> lap will count.

The best time of one lap from all official timed practice sessions will determine the starting position for the first heat. In the event of a tie, the next best lap time of the Drivers who have tied will determine their starting position.

Each driver must complete al least one lap in practice. Should this not be the case, in the first qualifying Heat he may be allowed to start at the discretion of the Stewards.

Cars from different divisions will run separately.

12.2 Information in English and in the host language of the Event will be given to the drivers in writing at the administrative checking.

### **14. QUALIFYING**

There will be 4 laps in the qualifying Heats.

14.4. The positions of cars absent from the grid will remain empty.

In each Heat, the drivers will be classified according to the number of laps completed. For those drivers having completed the same number of laps, the time of crossing the finish line will be decisive. Among the drivers with the same number of points in the Heat, the time will be the deciding factor. The driver coming 1 st will be awarded 1 point, the 2<sup>nd</sup> 2 points, the 3<sup>rd</sup> 3 points, and so on.

Those drivers who did complete less than 2 laps will be credited with 80 points.  
 Those drivers who did not start the Heat will be credited with 90 points.  
 Those drivers who were excluded from the Heat will be credited with 95 points.  
 Only those drivers having totalised less than 21 points in two Heats will be admitted to the Finals.

## 15. FINALS

There will be 6 laps in the Finals.

## 17. PENALTIES

The following list of examples is not exhaustive. The Stewards of the meeting have overall authority concerning the penalties imposed.

Moreover, the Stewards of the meeting themselves or upon the proposal of the Clerk of the Course may decide on any point which is not provide for the Regulations and apply penalties in conformity with the criteria of the code, of the European Championships Regulations and of these Supplementary Regulations.

## VI. PARC FERME – RESULT – PROTESTS

### 18. PARC FERME

Only those cars having taken part in the Finals must be brought by the drivers to the Parc Fermé immediately after the last race for which the driver qualified, except for cars damaged in an accident and not having completed the race.

The cars shall remain in the Parc Fermé for at least 30 minutes after the publication of the provisional results and until released by decision of the Stewards.

In this area, it is forbidden to make any repair to the vehicle or to carry out refuelling.

## 19. RESULTS

All results will be posted on the notice boards in the circuit RCT basis and at the paddock after the end of each Heat or Final.

## 20. PROTESTS – APPEALS

20.1 All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code.

All protest must be made in writing and handed to the Clerk of the Course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the Stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of € 500,00 as per the FIA Prescriptions.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit of € 2 000,00.

20.5. Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in an Article 181, 182 and 183 of the Code and also as set out in the Rules of the international Court of Appeal.

The amount of the appeal (FPAK) is € 2 500,00.

The amount of the appeal (FIA) is € 6 000,00.

## VII. PRIZES AND CUPS

### 21. PRIZES

The podium ceremony on the circuit will be held immediately after each race. The winners of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes must be present. Failure to attend this ceremony will be penalized by the loss of any monetary award / benefit associated with the corresponding position at the end of the race.

The general prize-giving will take place at the Circuit Tower by 19H00 on Sunday April 25. The prizes will be awarded in Euros.

## VIII. OTHER INFORMATION

### 22. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each driver is responsible for ensuring that a fire extinguisher is available within his own team area inside the paddock.

### 23. PROTECTION THE ENVIRONMENT

Each driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.

#### **24. DRIVERS`LIAISON OFFICER**

The two Driver`s Liaison Officers will be recognisable by wearing a specific tabard with the letters **“CRO”**.

They may be reached at the circuit RCT basis and will be present in time and place of all the Administrative and Technical checks as well as during Scrutineering.

#### **25. AUTHORISATION**

These Regulations have been agreed by FPAK with Visa nr. 031/CEAx/10 on 040210.  
The FIA Visa nr. is
